Preschoolers will have their own specialized, age-appropriate activities with their own counseling staff and will also participate in some all-Camp programming. Their daily schedule will include a nap/quiet time after lunch. Camp will provide the napping mats, but families are required to provide napping items such as blankets and/or pillows.
